• CRZ recommendation for establishment of new Lighthouse at Tajpur, Ramnagar, Purba Medinipur – by Directorate of Lighthouses and Lightships, Ministry of Shipping, Government of India

In conformity to the directions given in the minutes of the 2nd Meeting of the WBSCZMA, the Project Proponent submitted the CRZ map on 1:25,000 scales and gave presentation before the Members. During the presentation it was also found that the authorized institute (*Institute of Remote Sensing, Anna University, Chennai*) during mapping has observed accretion sand dune deposited in the confluence of the river to the sea, and depicted the same on the map also. The project is also found to lie beyond the NDZ and is a permissible activity.
